

# **Automotive Fast Fixes**

Cars represent a kind of freedom; the freedom to go where you want, the freedom to explore, and the freedom to make your own decisions. But what happens when your car breaks down?

How about doing a Fast Fix guide to help users keep their cars and trucks running and in good working condition? Here's a list of topics to help get you started—but keep in mind that there are plenty of other possible auto-fixes, so feel free to propose a guide you don't see here. Just be sure that your proposed fix isn't already documented on <u>iFixit.com</u>.

Since repair procedures can differ for every auto, run a <u>search</u> using the full name of the car or truck you want to work on, including manufacturer, model, and year. For example: If you'd like to create a spark plug replacement guide for your truck, first search for "2019 Ford F-250" and not just "Ford" or "Ford F-250."

Fixes that involve the use of a car jack or stand are prohibited. Please refer to the <u>Project Safety</u> page for more information.
