
PUTTING IT TOGETHER: BUILDING A SUCCESSFUL PROJECT

It's no secret how to excel at the iFixit Technical Writing Project. Check out these **three** key pieces to a successful project.




Read

Carefully reading project instructions will save you tons of time—and heartache.

- Reading the project instructions is a requirement.
- Stick to the Guide Builder Roadmap.
- Most problems can be avoided by following the directions.





On average, students who read the directions complete the project in half the time.


Communicate

Email check-ins with iFixit staff are key to an awesome experience.

- Email iFixit staff regularly.
- Check in after every unit.

80% of students said email communication with iFixit was "extremely helpful."




Revise

Revising your work based on feedback is essential, not "extra."



- Leave plenty of time at each unit for revising your work.
- Both photos and text are important, so be prepared to re-shoot photos along with rewriting text.
